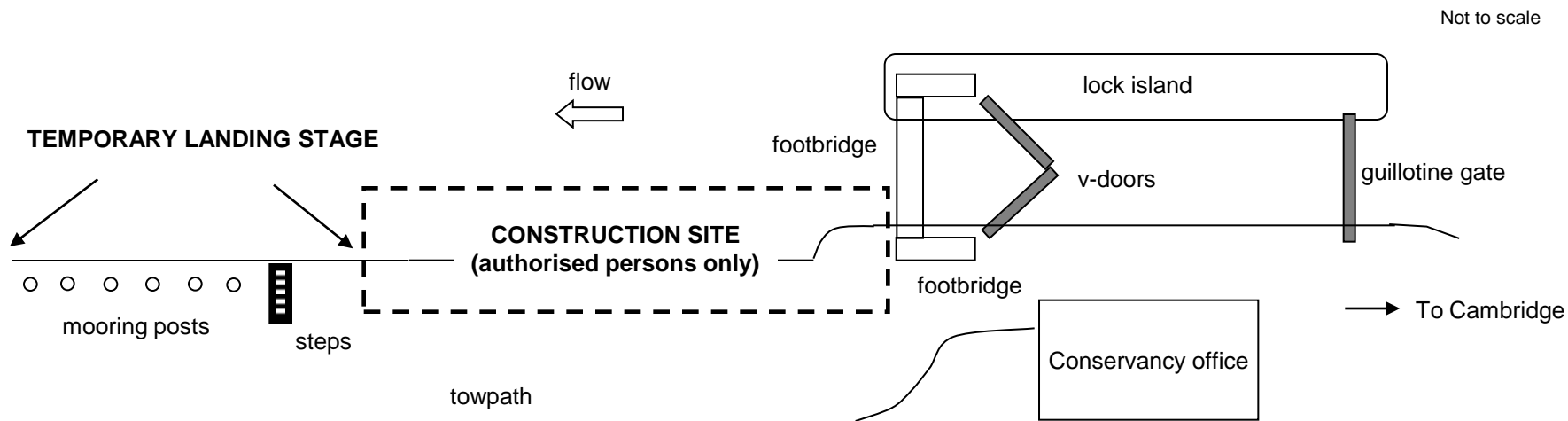


TEMPORARY LANDING ARRANGEMENTS, BAITS BITE LOCK DOWNSTREAM LANDING STAGE OCTOBER/NOVEMBER 2011



- Drake Towing Ltd will be undertaking the refurbishment of the downstream landing stage at Baits Bite Lock on behalf of the Conservators of the River Cam
- The start date for these works is Monday 3rd October 2011. The project is expected to last for 5 weeks.
- The construction site will be fenced off. Members of the public will be prohibited from entering this area during the works.
- A temporary landing stage has been provided immediately downstream of the construction site. It is demarcated with wooden posts. Mooring posts and a set of steps and a handrail have been provided for safety. Rowers are asked to portage using this temporary landing stage.
- Customers with special access needs are asked to contact the Conservancy office at Baits Bite in advance to make arrangements (01223 863785, Mondays to Fridays, 9am to 5pm)
- River users must take extra care when approaching Baits Bite Lock. Contractors' barges will be moored near the downstream lock entrance and the piling works will at times be noisy. There will be additional vehicles using the towpath near the lock.
